Dear Client,

Greetings! If you submit poultry samples for AI serology testing to the Pennsylvania Animal Diagnostic Laboratory System (PADLS) labs, there is a minor change to our fee for the Avian Influenza Agar Gel Immuno-diffusion (AGID) testing.

Serology samples submitted to satisfy the show requirements, NPIP program, AI Monitored flock Program testing and Live Bird Market programs will continue to be discounted and fees for this testing will remain unchanged. Testing fees for serology samples submitted for diagnostic testing or other non-regulatory testing have been increased slightly.

We expect this change will have minimal impact on most producers as the majority of the AGID testing in the Commonwealth is done to satisfy regulatory testing needs, and that fee will remain unchanged.

The (PADLS) fee changes that will be effective April 25, 2016 are outlined below.
